## **JUNE MEETING RECAP**

At its June 1, 2022, meeting, the Homelessness Committee heard the following presentation:

- **AB 2233 (Quirk-Silva & Garcia): Excess State Land: Development of Affordable Housing:** SGVCOG Management Analyst, Victoria Urenia, presented on AB 2233, which would require the State Department of General Services (DGS) to develop a plan to facilitate development of affordable housing on State-owned excess land. The Homelessness Committee approved a motion to recommend Governing Board support AB 2233 (Quirk-Silva & Garcia).
- **LA County CEO Homeless Initiative Listening Session:** Following the adjournment of the Homelessness Committee, LA County CEO's Office Homeless Initiative facilitated a listening session to discuss and hear feedback on the County funding opportunities and funding process for local jurisdictions available to both cities and councils of governments. For FY 22-23, the County Board of Supervisors made \$10 million available. SGVCOG staff and representatives from member cities provided feedback on regional needs, system gaps, and the importance of access and quality of data.
