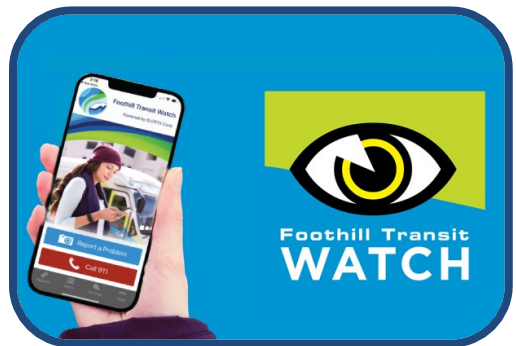
Reduced Foothill Transit Fares Through July 2: Providing Relief During Record Gas Prices

Foothill Transit is doing its share to bring some relief to San Gabriel Valley as gas prices reach unprecedented highs. All Foothill Transit rides are \$1.75 or less through July 2. Riders will only have to pay local fares, and can save up to 72 percent on Silver Streak and Commuter Express Lines 490, 493, 495, 498, 499, and 699. This fare sale, which brings all fares to the local fare rate, makes commuting into downtown LA even more affordable. We recognize the changing needs of the community during these challenging times, and are hopeful that this fare sale will also provide an economic and sustainable mobility option that encourages commuters to consider public transit.
