PROJECT OVERVIEW

SGV FORWARD is a proposed demonstration project that will:

- ✓ Add dedicated bus lanes on key corridors
- ✓ Upgrade traffic signals to help buses move more efficiently
- ✓ Improve bus stop amenities
- ✓ Make walking and biking connections safer and more accessible

These improvements are expected to make bus service faster, cut travel times by up to 25%, and provide stronger connections to jobs, schools, and healthcare.

This project would benefit the public through:


-  More connections between schools, jobs, and healthcare
-  More accessible transit with better bike and pedestrian connections
-  Job opportunities, increased business revenue, and economic growth
-  Faster, more reliable buses, with 10 to 25% savings on bus travel times¹
-  Proposed bus lanes serving more than 10 existing bus routes, including Metro Line 70 and Foothill Transit Line 486 and Silver Streak
