BACKGROUND

SGVCOG's Alameda Corridor-East (ACE) Project is a comprehensive program of grade separation constructions and safety and mobility upgrades at railway crossings. To date, ACE has completed 14 rail-roadway grade separations. Three grade separations are under construction with another two grade separations and eight crossing safety projects in their design phases. These projects eliminate collisions between trains and motorists, improve the reliability and capacity of train operations, and sustain the growth of freight movement and associated economic sectors in Southern California.

The committee will be touring various completed and ongoing ACE construction projects in the San Gabriel Valley. The tour will include visits of the following grade separations projects:

- Durfee Avenue (Pico Rivera)
- Fairway Drive (Industry/Los Angeles County)
- Fullerton Avenue (Industry/Los Angeles County)
- Puente Avenue (Industry/Los Angeles County)
- Nogales Street (Industry/Los Angeles County)
- Sunset Avenue (Industry)
- Turnbull Canyon Road (Industry/Los Angeles County)

SGVCOG Community Outreach Project Manager, Ricky Choi, will provide a tour of ACE construction sites for the Public Works TAC.
