President Shevlin has been on the Coordinating Council for approximately 20 years and served in all the executive positions. She has served on the Monrovia Reads and the Chamber of Commerce Boards of Directors and is a past president of the Foothill Unity Center Auxiliary. She also serves as the Monrovia City Council's liaison to the Library Board and delegate to Healing Connections, San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments, Southern California Association of Governments, Foothill Transit, and San Gabriel Valley Mosquito & Vector Control District. She serves as alternate to the Monrovia Public Library Foundation, YES Program, Community Media of the Foothills, Chamber of Commerce Board & Government Affairs Committee, League of California Cities - Los Angeles Division, Foothill Workforce Investment Board, and Sanitation Districts 15 and 22 of Los Angeles County. President Shevlin also participates in the Monroe, Wild Rose, and Plymouth Elementary Schools and Clifton Middle School Adopt-a-School Program.
