



BACKGROUND

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) recently approved their budget for the upcoming fiscal year. The budget was developed to reflect the needs and preferences of customers, riders, and residents of Los Angeles County. Due to the 2026 FIFA World Cup, Metro's FY 2026-2027 Budget came before the Metro Board of Directors for approval in May.
